Woodwind Repair Technician or Woodwind Repair Apprentice

Peak Performance Woodwinds in Kansas City, MO is seeking to fill **one of two full-time positions**: A woodwind repair technician, or a woodwind repair apprentice. **Approximate start date April 2024.**

-Starting pay for Woodwind Repair Apprentice: \$15.50/hour

-Starting pay for Woodwind Repair Technician: \$19/hour

-Eligible for retirement benefits (IRA) after 6 months working at Peak Performance Woodwinds.

Duties will include the following:

- Assisting in repair and servicing of saxophones, clarinets, oboes, flutes, and bassoons.
- Close communication and collaboration with others in the shop.
- Fabrication of parts and tools.
- Tracking work hours and service hours on client instruments.
- Assisting in representing Peak Performance Woodwinds at tradeshows, conventions, and other events.
- Assisting in the organization and management of supplies, parts, tools, etc.
- Interacting with clients, customers, industry professionals, and most importantly the shop pets at Peak Performance Woodwinds (applicants must be comfortable with dogs and cats).
- Working closely with Will Peak to improve the services offered by Peak Performance Woodwinds.



Additional duties might include:

- Operating a 3D printer
- Assisting in product design and manufacturing

- Assisting with managing the online store

Required skills and experience for <u>apprentice</u>:

- Some prior experience in instrument repair
- Applicable proficiency playing a woodwind instrument
- Good organization and problem-solving skills
- Good time-management skills
- Patient, receptive to guidance and criticism, eager to improve
- Respectful to others, good communication skills, honesty
- Good/comfortable with dogs and cats (PPW is located in my house, and I have three dogs and a cat).
- Physically fit to work safely and effectively in a repair shop.

Required skills and experience for technician:

- All of the above requirements
- ~5 or more years of woodwind repair experience

The following credentials are preferred, but not required:

- High level of proficiency playing a woodwind instrument
- Competency playing multiple woodwind instruments
- Competency with computers and other technology
- Particular interest in saxophones, clarinets, or oboes.

Applications will be reviewed until the position is filled, however we hope to fill the position sometime **prior to the summer of 2025.** The hiring process will include a preliminary interview, bench test, and follow-up interview.
